



➤ The Problem

Adult illiteracy is an underlying issue in the United States with 32 million adults who cannot read above a fifth grade level. In Colorado, 340,000 adults do not have a high school diploma or GED certificate which creates significant road blocks to employment, advanced degrees, economic development, and basic community building including having the literacy and mathematical skills to support their children through primary school.



➤ Our Solution

The Learning Source offers integrated and bundled educational opportunities at low to no cost to adults and their families with substantial social and economic barriers. By creating a network of partnerships throughout the Denver metro region, The Learning Source empowers adults by providing pathways to opportunity for those marginalized by circumstance, poverty, and social justice issues.

➤ Our Impact

Since its founding in 1964, The Learning Source has assisted nearly 50,000 adults and their families achieve their educational goals in the Denver metro region with the support of 13 partners in 5 counties (and growing).

➤ Our History

The Learning Source began in a church basement with only 40 students, 16 volunteers, and no paid staff. Today, it is one of the oldest and largest adult education agencies in Colorado with innovative adult education programs and partnerships to provide a well-rounded experience for adult learners.
